## **T.B.M.M.'s 22<sup>nd</sup> TERM 4<sup>th</sup> LEGISLATIVE YEAR OF MPs MONITORING REPORT** (01 OCTOBER 2005 – 30 SEPTEMBER 2006)

This monitoring report includes TBMM (Turkish Great National Assembly) 22<sup>nd</sup> Term 4<sup>th</sup> Legislative Year legislative and regulatory activities of MPs as well as the other parliamentary activities and attendance of MPs to General Assembly and Committee Meetings.

By informing voters objectively about their representatives elected by them, TUMIKOM aims to make contributions to the development of voter conscious.

In addition, 4<sup>th</sup> National Report of TUMIKOM also tries to announce the performance of MPs objectively to public opinion by monitoring their legislative year activities by a voter initiative which is independent from both their parties and MPs.

The sources of this report are the official documents of 22<sup>nd</sup> Term 4<sup>th</sup> Legislative Year which are published by the Head of Parliament after the end of MPs' objection period. These official documents have been separated to categories with a special method developed by TUMIKOM and after analyzing each data, report was prepared. However, any of the documents was changed. Categories were determined by using the original terminology of TBMM.

TBMM 22<sup>nd</sup> Term 4<sup>th</sup> Legislative Year MP Monitoring Report was prepared under 10 main topics and 209 categories. The names of the MPs were not evaluated as an activity value if they were not in an activity.
